Europe designed to raise global awareness of the need for source plasma collection, recognize the contributions of plasma donors to saving and improving lives, and to increase understanding about lifesaving plasma protein

therapies and the conditions they treat; and

Plasma-derived and recombinant therapies, collectively known as plasma protein therapies are unique, WHEREAS,

biologic products for which no substitutes exist, save and improve lives of individuals throughout Maryland

and the United States; and

WHEREAS, Plasma protein therapies are used to treat many conditions including hemophilia and other bleeding

> disorders, primary immune deficiencies, alpha-1 antitrypsin deficiency, hereditary angioedema, chronic inflammatory demyelinating polyneuropathy, idiopathic thrombocytopenic purpura, and Rh negative

pregnancies; and

WHEREAS; These therapies substantially increase quality of life, extend life expectancy, and improve patient outcomes for

an estimated 2,300 individuals in the state of Maryland; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LAWRENCE J. HOGAN, JR., GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, do hereby proclaim OCTOBER 9 - 15, 2016 as PLASMA AWARENESS WEEK in Maryland, and commend this observance to all of our citizens.
